#### **GUIDE TO COMPLETING THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATION FORM**

Thank you for applying to Leeds Beckett University. This form is divided into four sections (please make sure that you complete all sections). This form is available as a PDF. Alternatively, you can apply online

Please note that as an international applicant, your eligibility to study a part-time or weekend course in the UK may depend on your immigration status. If you wish to apply for part-time or weekend study please check with your visa issuing authority before submitting your application. If you do wish to apply for part-time or weekend study please make this clear on your application form as we will process all international applications for full-time study unless instructed otherwise.

#### Section 1: PERSONAL DETAILS

COURSE TITLE: Please use the correct full name for the course as in our prospectus or on our website <a href="http://courses.leedsbeckett.ac.uk">http://courses.leedsbeckett.ac.uk</a>. You may choose 3 courses. All international students must study a full-time course in order to be eligible for a Tier 4 visa.

LEVEL OF ENTRY: This would normally be Year 1. However, if you have qualifications or relevant experience that you think would enable you to enter into an alternative year or have completed your first or second year at another institution, you may indicate this by selecting a higher entry year. You should be guided by the information available on the Online Prospectus under Entry Requirements found on each individual course description.

ADDRESS: This must be your permanent home address but you may also specify an alternative address for correspondence (eg an agent). If you do this, we will send all mail to that address instead.

- v) Please comment on the applicant's **English language proficiency** ability to speak, write and comprehend English.

Once the form is completed it should be posted, emailed or faxed (with copies of all documents) to the International Office at the address on page 1. The application will then be assessed and all decisions will be communicated by the International Office.

# We will send you one of three replies:

UNCONDITIONAL - You have been accepted and we enclose an acceptance form which you should return to us to accept your place on the course.

CONDITIONAL - You have been accepted provided that you meet certain conditions, for example you achieve an IELTS score of 6.0. Once you meet these conditions, you should contact us immediately with proof of meeting the conditions and we will then send you an unconditional offer letter.

REJECTION - We are sorry but we cannot accept you onto the course. Your application will go no further for this course. Occasionally we may reject you on a certain course, but offer you a place on an alternative course if we feel it is appropriate. Please ensure that you would be happy with this before accepting the offer.

### **Important Notice for Non-UK Citizens**
