

Enhance your Experience - Live in a Homestay with a Canadian Family

St. Lawrence College provides a homestay program, which is an economical and personable way for students to be introduced to Canada. We find that our first-year students who stay in homestay adjust to their academic life more successfully. It is a wonderful opportunity to learn about Canadian culture and to practice their language skills with Canadian family! Communication is vital, and we encourage all students to talk regularly with their host families. We strive to make everyone's experience positive and rewarding. Our homestays are checked in advance and are regularly monitored to provide a variety of services to support the student.

The Host Family will provide the following:

- A private room with bed, linens, dresser or wardrobe, nightstand, lamp, and appropriate amount of space for the student's belongings.
- A safe living accommodation (smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, main exit ways properly cleared)
- Healthy snacks and nutritious meals. As much as possible, dinner will be served in a family gathering.
- Use of common areas in the house (living room, bathroom, etc.) and laundry facilities.

Note: The Homestay program aims to giving our international students and host family a great experience through a cultural exchange. Treat the hosts like your own family. In order to get the most out of your Homestay experience, you should try to partake in the family activities and be part of the family.

Expectations of Student & Host Family

- 1. Room and Living Accommodation:** You will be provided a private room with all basic living accommodations (bed, linens, dresser or wardrobe, nightstand, lamp, and appropriate amount of space for the student's belongings). Students are expected to keep their own room clean. Students are responsible for providing their own shampoo, shower gel, and other hygiene/toiletry products.
- 2. Laundry:** Laundry facilities and detergent are included in the price of Homestay. Students are responsible for washing their own clothes. Laundry instructions/expectations should be communicated and shown to the student. If you get placed in a Homestay in an apartment and there are coin operated machines, you will be provided with money to use laundry machines.
- 3. Internet:** Provided with a stable internet connection
- 4. Alcohol usage/smoking:** Some families may drink alcohol on occasion. If you are not okay with the use of alcohol, please indicate this in your application and we will place you in a home where alcohol is not used.
- 5. Food:** Students will be provided with healthy snacks and nutritious meals. As much as possible, dinner will be served in a family gathering. If the family goes out for a meal, the Homestay family should pay the bill. The family should discuss with the students how to proceed for breakfast and lunch. Students should

inform the family if they cannot be home for dinner. Homestay families need to be aware of dietary restrictions (preferences, allergies, etc.). The Homestay may want to take the student with them to the grocery store occasionally so that they can get a sense of what kind of foods you like to eat.

Please note: *Please keep in mind that students will need to communicate their preferences (e.g. portions, likes and dislikes). It is important to discuss this with the family. The Homestay family will do their best to accommodate you, but students will need to keep an open mind with regards to trying new foods.*

6. **Safety:** Students are provided a safe living accommodation (smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, clear exit routes)
 7. **Placement length:** Our Homestay contract requires students to sign a 4-month contract. You are welcome to stay longer. This must be discussed with the Homestay family.
 8. **Curfew:** Curfews are not enforced by the Homestay family. Students should discuss with the Homestay family if they plan to be home late, and be respectful of Homestay families schedules.
 9. **Houseguests:** Students should ask their host families permission when asking to have a friend come over for the day, or stay for the night.
 10. **Cleaning:** Students can be asked to help the family with light household chores such as helping clean up after dinner, doing their dishes, etc. For some students, participating in house chores may be something new. Instructions may be needed and your Homestay family will communicate this to you.
 11. **Distance from the College:** Must live at a reasonable distance from the College and live near a bus route
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Homestay Placement Details

1. **Fee Payment:** The Homestay fee is \$28.00 per day. Homestay fees are due on the 1st of each month. The student must pay the homestay family directly. The payment methods should be discussed between the student and family (cash, email transfer, etc.). There is a \$10.00 per day late fee for each late day after the payment deadline.
 - **Early Arrival:** If you arrive prior to the first day of the month, you will pay your Homestay \$28.00 per night for the number of nights that you stay in the home before the 1st of the month.
 - **Trial Period:** The first 2 weeks is a trial period. If you decide that this placement is not suitable for you within the first 14 nights, the Homestay Coordinator will attempt to help you look for other accommodations. Student will be allowed to move out only if really necessary. This will be at the discretion of the Homestay Coordinator. **After the trial period**, you must commit for the rest of the 4 month stay.
 - **Student Absences:** In the event you plan to be away from the home for more than a week, a reduced daily rate will apply beginning on the eighth day at \$15 per day.
 - **Homestay Change:** If you desire another Homestay placement without a valid reason to move, you will have to pay the \$250.00 Homestay Placement fee again

- For this reason, please use the 14-night trial period to carefully consider whether or not the placement will be satisfactory for the remainder of the semester.

2. **Placement length:** Minimum stay of 4 months required.
3. **Moving Out:** If you decide to leave the home before the end of the semester, a 30-day notice must be given to the homestay host, and a \$13.00 per day fee will be paid to the homestay host for the period remaining (except in very unusual circumstances and by agreement of the host).

Application Process

1. Fill out the **Homestay Application form**.
2. Provide a **recent photo of yourself**. This will be given to the host family.
3. Pay the **CAD\$250.00** Homestay Placement Fee. (This is **non-refundable** and is **not a partial payment** of the monthly homestay fee). Include copy of your payment confirmation with application.
4. Send your application package to the International Student Advisor.

Arrival

Once you have been matched with a Homestay family, the Homestay Coordinator will send a Family Introduction email to you, introducing you to the family. At that point, arrival plans should be made. Students are expected to get to a Kingston or Cornwall transit point (train, bus and airport) and the homestay family will pick you up at that location. Our homestay coordinators will communicate this to the student. We recommend communicating with the family before you arrive. This helps create a relationship early on, and you will get to know the family better before arriving.

Early/late arrivals must be indicated on the student's application form for planning purposes so that the homestay family can ensure they are available for your arrival.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. *What is the minimum stay?*

- The minimum stay of our Homestay Program is four months (one semester).

2. *What kind of housing is available in a Homestay?*

- There are various types of houses from host to host. It could be a house, an apartment or a townhouse. Please note, we cannot guarantee a specific type of home.

3. *Are utilities included?*

- Yes, it is all-inclusive (electricity, gas and water).

4. *Will there be any other students in the Homestay?*

- There may be other students in the house if the host families have suitable space for more than one student.

5. *Will I have my own bathroom?*

- It depends on the number of bathrooms in the house and the number of people living in the house. Usually, students share the bathroom with other students or the host family.

6. *Can I have a guest come to my Homestay?*

- Yes, but you should discuss this with your host family first.

7. *Who is the first point of contact if a problem arises?*

- Your homestay coordinator should be your first point of contact for advice, or if a problem arises. Usually the homestay coordinator will liaise with the International Student Advisor on the appropriate campus for further action. If you cannot reach the homestay coordinator, or they are on vacation, please contact the International Student Advisor.

7 Homestay Agreement & Medical Authorization

I, am an applicant for the St. Lawrence College Homestay program,

Agreement

I understand that my participation in the Homestay Program depends upon my following the rules and standards of the Homestay Program, and the instructions given to me during the Program. Failure to follow these rules, standards and instructions, may result in the immediate termination of this service, expulsion from the home and loss of any paid fees. My participation in the Homestay Program may be terminated at the sole discretion of the International Office at St. Lawrence College.

In addition, I specifically agree:

- To pay for all phone call charges incurred by me, when authorized to use the family's home phone / mobile phone. (Please make sure to obtain detailed information about the costs involved before making any calls);
- To participate in the Homestay Program for a **minimum of four months**;
- To give my host family **thirty days written notice** before I leave the Homestay Program.

General Conditions

The daily rate is \$28.00 and this includes a private furnished room, 3 meals per day and access to the home's internet and laundry services. Monthly fees are paid directly to the Homestay host family.

Note: Do not carry large amounts of cash with you when you travel to Canada. You can withdraw funds from a Canadian Bank ATM once you are here to pay for your first month's homestay fee.

- Monthly homestay payments are due on the **1st** day of every month. There is a **\$10.00 per day late fee** for each late day after the payment deadline. Please make sure to pay the **FULL** amount **ON TIME**, since we cannot arrange a new homestay if a student has been asked to leave a homestay due to late payments.
- If you arrive prior to the first day of the month you will pay your Homestay Host on arrival a prorated payment based on **CAD\$28.00 per night** for the number of nights that you stay in the home that month.
- If you are going to be away from the homestay for more than 7 days, a fee of \$15.00 per day will be charged for your room while you are away instead of the usual \$28.00 daily fee.
- The first 2 weeks (14 nights) of Homestay are a trial period. If you decide that this placement is not suitable for you within the first 14 nights, the Homestay Coordinator will attempt to help you to find other accommodations. A \$28.00 charge per night that you stayed in the home will be deducted from the total that you paid upon arrival, and you will receive the balance as a refund.
- At the end of the second week, if you decide to stay in the home that was arranged for you, you are making a commitment to stay until the end of the semester.
- After the first 14 nights, a move may only be requested under extenuating circumstances. **If you feel unsafe or if a very serious problem occurs, which cannot be resolved, please speak to our Homestay Coordinator, who will help you find other accommodations immediately.**
- **If you decide to leave the home before the end of the semester, a 30-day notice must be given to the homestay host, and a \$13.00 per day fee will be paid to the homestay host for the period remaining** (except in very unusual circumstances and by agreement of the host).

Note: In the event that you request to move to a new Homestay family, without a valid reason to move, **you will have to pay the \$250.00 Homestay Placement fee again**, in addition to **paying the Homestay Fee for your new family hosts**. For this reason, please use the 14 night trial period to carefully consider whether or not the placement will be satisfactory for the remainder of the semester.

Only in the rare case that you have a legitimate reason for leaving before the end of the semester (to be determined by the Homestay Coordinator and the Associate Director of International Education) a new Homestay will be found for you at no additional Placement fee.

Release from Liability

I understand that there are risks associated with travel and living in a foreign country in addition to the normal risks of daily life. I understand that I should obtain insurance to ensure coverage against loss or damage to myself or my property. I understand that I must maintain medical insurance, the cost of which is **included** in the tuition fees for my program at St. Lawrence College.

I hereby fully release and discharge St. Lawrence College, its agents, employees, officers and Board members, and the host family, from any and all claims, causes of action, expenses, damages and demands of any and every kind and nature whatsoever, at law or at equity or pursuant to any statute, which I may have for any injury, loss or damage to any person or property arising in any way from: (a) my participation in the Homestay Program; or (b) my actions outside of the Homestay Program, including but not limited to, independent travel or absences from the College.

I shall indemnify St. Lawrence College, its agents, employees, officers and Board members and the host family from any and all claims, damages, financial obligations or liabilities which may be brought or made against them as a result of any loss, damage or injury to any person or property caused by my acts or omissions.

Medical Treatment

If I become incapable, in the opinion of a registered medical practitioner, of consenting to medical treatment, I nominate the Homestay Coordinator, International Student Advisor, Associate Director –International Education, Director – International Education, or an adult member of my host family to consent to medical treatment on my behalf when a registered medical practitioner advises that such treatment is in the best interests of my health and well-being.

St. Lawrence College International Office Staff, the Homestay Coordinator, or the host family may take reasonable actions in the event of my injury, illness, or incapacity, including transporting me back to my home country at my own expense.

I waive and release all claims against St. Lawrence College, its agents, employees, officers and Board members, the Homestay Coordinator, or the host family, for any decisions or actions made relating to my incapacity, illness or injuries.
